

**JUNEAU CHAMBER OF COMMERCE
MINUTES
JULY 10, 2018**

Ron will be finding the president of the Historical Society to give the their check for \$100.00

The Business Directory will need to be reprinted with current changes.

Ron said the next meeting of the Utility Board is coming up and we should be receiving \$1,000 that will be donated.
